

# Remembering a Foundation Leader

Norm Kirschenbaum, a dedicated educator and community leader, was born and raised in East Los Angeles to Irving and Mollie Kirschenbaum. As the youngest of three children, he grew up alongside his older brother, Larry, and sister, Phyllis, all of whom attended schools within the Montebello Unified School District. After graduating from Montebello High School in 1958, Norm pursued higher education at Los Angeles City College, East Los Angeles Junior College, and California State University, Los Angeles.

Norm's passion for education led him back to the Montebello Unified School District, where he embarked on a distinguished career. In his twenties, he began his administrative journey as Principal of Grandview Elementary School, followed by tenures at La Merced Elementary School and Colmar Elementary School. His leadership skills propelled him to the District Office, where he served as Director of Instruction and Assistant Superintendent. In 1995, he was appointed Superintendent of the Montebello Unified School District, a role he held for four years.

After 36 years with the Montebello District, Norm continued his educational leadership as Superintendent of the Hacienda-La Puente Unified School District and the Charter Oak Unified School District. Even after a brief retirement, his commitment to education persisted, leading to his appointment as Superintendent for the Tri-Cities Regional Occupational Program, serving the Whittier Union High School District and the El Rancho Unified School District.

Beyond his professional achievements, Norm and his wife, Theola, were active residents of Whittier. They contributed significantly to the Boys & Girls Club of Whittier and the Whittier Public Library Foundation. Norm was particularly instrumental in fundraising efforts for the Whittier Central Library, serving on the foundation's board for 16 years and as its president for four years.

Norm is survived by his beloved wife, Theola; his five children, Karen, Alisa, Jeff, Vicki, and Rodney; twelve grandchildren; and numerous cherished friends.


# Whittier Reads returns April 2025 with a new exciting book The Boys of Riverside






